Job Purpose	To assist as directed, with all aspects of the preparation of food and beverages to the standards required by the school. To deputise for the catering manager when they are absent
Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● The preparation and simple cooking of food & beverages.● Serving pupils at the counter as required.● To undertake all aspects of cleaning equipment (light and heavy), walls (up to 6ft.) floors, fixtures and fittings, cooking utensils, cutlery, glassware etc. as directed.● During service times, to ensure that tables and counters are as clean as reasonably practicable and adequately stocked.● To maintain a high standard of personal and general cleanliness and hygiene to comply with statutory and school regulations.● To attend training activities and/or meetings as required.● Occasionally, to assist with special functions at the school which may be outside of normal working hours.● To report any children's comments or complaints and take any necessary remedial action if appropriate.● Report immediately any accidents, fire, theft, loss, damage, unfit food or other irregularities and take such action as may be appropriate or possible.● Deputise for the catering manager when absent, including:<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Recording temperature of hot protein food● To follow the oven opening and closing procedure ● The duties above are neither exclusive nor exhaustive and the post holder may be required by the Headteacher to carry out appropriate duties within the context of the job, skills and grade.
