Routines and staffing

Children need to be in the playground, ready to come into class, by 8.45am, and will finish their day at 3.15pm. If you need to speak to us briefly, teachers will be available on the playground from 8.35am on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Please contact the office if you need a longer meeting with us. In Year 5, we aim for the children to be independent so, whenever possible, please encourage your child to come and talk to us themselves if they have any queries or worries.

The children will have two PE lessons a week — Tuesday morning and Thursday afternoon. Home learning

Home learning should follow the themes and guidance outlined in the policy (see the school website). We will be sending home a weekly task (alternating between SPaG and maths), which is given out on Monday, and needs to be handed in by Friday. It is highly recommended that you listen to your child read every day for about 15 minutes and then to discuss what they have read with them. It is also very important that your child practises their times tables every day if they have not yet learned them all. This should be done in regular short bursts (around 5 minutes per day). Times Tables Rock Stars is a brilliant way to do this (and enables me to track their progress) but any method that works for your family is great.
