Remote Education Provision at Newnham Croft Primary School

At Newnham Croft, we are committed to providing high-quality education for all pupils. In line with Department for Education guidance, remote education is only used in exceptional cases—when pupils are unable to attend school due to short-term illness, recovery from surgery or injury, or other limited circumstances, but are still well enough to learn from home.

We firmly believe that **in-person attendance** is **the best way** for pupils to learn, develop socially, and thrive. Remote education is therefore considered a **short-term**, **last-resort solution**, used only when it is not possible for a child to attend school in person and where a temporary alternative is needed to prevent learning loss.

When remote education is required:

- Pupils will receive high-quality, meaningful learning opportunities across the curriculum, tailored to their age and needs.
- Communication and feedback between pupils and teachers will be maintained through appropriate channels.
- Where needed, paper-based resources or access to devices may be provided.
- We work closely with families to support access and engagement, especially for pupils with additional needs.

Remote education will be reviewed regularly and will form part of a clear plan to support the pupil's **return to school as soon as possible**. It will never be used as a disciplinary measure or a long-term substitute for school attendance.
